

I Kings 19:1-5

1. And Ahab told Jezebel all that Elijah had done, and withal how he had slain all the prophets with the sword.

2. Then Jezebel sent a messenger unto Elijah, saying, so let the gods do to me, and more also, if I make not thy life as the life of one of them by to morrow about this time.

3. And when he saw that, he arose, and went for his life, and came to Beersheba, which belongeth to Judah, and left his servant there.

4. But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a juniper tree: and he requested for himself that he might die; and said, It is enough; now, O Lord, take away my life; for I am not better than my fathers.

5. And as he lay and slept under a juniper tree, behold, then an angel touched him, and said unto him, Arise and eat.

Elijah was a great man of God, and was doing great things for the Lord! But fear of death made him to run away from the Jezebel when he heard that Jezebel is after his life.

Fear comes by hearing and hearing the contradiction to the Word of God and believing that what God has promised in His Word will not come to pass. We as a child of God and especially minister of God must understand that:

1). Fear is bondage.

- 2). Fear is full of torment
- 3). Fear will attack your faithfulness
- 4). Fear stops greater blessings that come from God.

Instead of feeding the bad news stirring up the fear, let us put God's Word in our heart. When God's Word is rooted and grounded in our hearts it prevails: "So mightily grew the Word of God and prevailed" (Acts 19:20).

We must understand that God's Word spoken by God into our lives surely fulfill its purpose and then will return back to Him. And we must also know that our safety lies in:

1). KNOWING GOD`S WORD. 2). MEDITATING ON GOD`S WORD. 3). STANDING ON GOD`S WORD.

No matter what happens or what kind of news contrary to God's Word we hear, let continue to stand on the Word of God till we see the victory manifest!

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen." (Hebrews 11:1).
