



POWER OF JESUS' WORDS

Jesus spoke everything into existence and look what the Bible says about Jesus, “1. In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. 3. **All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made**” (John 1:1-3). And further we read in Genesis chapter 1:3, “And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.”

Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest thou? 6. ...But Jesus stooped down, and with his finger wrote on the ground as though he heard them not” (John 8:4-6).

Scribes and Pharisees were standing there with big stones in their hand to stone that woman. But Jesus was silent. And during his silence he wrote something on the ground. Everyone were convicted. And finally Jesus said to them, “He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her” Here we see that in his silence and in his words here was great power being manifested. So one thing I realized that whether Jesus spoke any words or whether he kept silent it was for the benefit of the people.

When Jesus was hanging on the Cross listened to his words what he said, “Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do....” (Luke 23:34). For people's benefit he requested his Father not to punish them for what they have done to him.

And for your and my salvation, for forgiveness of sins, and for giving us eternal life, he paid the price of His Blood, death of the Cross and **did not open his mouth** and was silent completely. Read carefully the following verses: “5. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. 6. All We like sheep have gone astray; we have turned everyone to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. 7. He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth” (Isaiah 53:5-7).
