

"10. Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. 11. Put on the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places." (Ephesians 6:10-12).

If you see and observe that you and I we all are who call upon His Name are having daily battles waiting for us to face and we are in the battle every day. But thank the Lord that strength comes from the union with our Lord Jesus Christ and we are ultimately the winner as we put on the whole armor of God.

So let us take courage from the Word of God today as we are in the midst of this critical time and "Be strong in the Lord" And let us shout and say out loud, "With Christ in the vessel, we can smile at the storm!"
