



Blessed Invitation

“1. O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. 2. Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms. 3. For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods” (Psalms 95:1-3).

Being invited into the Presence of God is blessed thing! This is the invitation to come and worship in the Presence of God.

II. WHAT WE ARE
