SUBMISSIVE LEADERSHIP

3011 AUGUST 2013 In today's Christendom leadership is totally misunderstood. It is replaced by controlling nature rather than leading by genuine lifestyle example! Let us look in the life of Moses. He was an outstanding leader in the Bible.

1. HOPE AND FAITH: When Moses was born his parents saw that he was a proper child and they wanted to spare his life and therefore by faith they sent him down into the river. And amazing thing is by faith Pharaoh's daughter took Moses out of river as her own. But actually his parents looked after his childhood. But Bible says when Moses came of age, he refused the house of Pharaoh, the fame and wealth and chose God and his own people. And because Moses had HOPE and FAITH in God he could do it (Hebrews 11:24). Today's Christian leadership has become feeble by the wrong kind of confession by the so called leaders: "I cannot do beyond this. I am not able!" and so on. And that shows the lack of hope and faith in God! As a Christian leader we need to have these qualities HOPE and FAITH in God!

What is faith? "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not see" (Hebrews 11:1). Further Bible says, "20. But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead? 26. For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also" (James 2:20). 3. OBEDIENCE: Christian leader under the submissive leadership God must have vision and must take right decisions. Actually Moses was sent by God to Pharaoh to negotiate with him to release the people of Israel from Egypt. He was busy with Pharaoh to negotiate with him and at the same time he was pronouncing plagues on them. But the great thing of Moses was that in his busy schedule he did not forget to obey the Lord regarding the **PASSOVER.** Moses commanded to observe the Passover even in the strange land. Because it was right thing to do since it was a command from God. The Passover was the picture of covering sin and redemption provided by the shed Blood of Jesus Christ on the Cross of Calvary! People who are called for the Christian leadership must be obedient to the Lord first and lead God's people in obedience to Christ! Our obedience to Christ shows our degree of love for Him and for others!

Let us be a submissive leaders ready to be being spent and be obedient to the Word of God and ready to confess that "I can do all things through Jesus Christ who strengthens me" (Philippians 4:13).
