- 2). Caleb was fully devoted to God. He was holding on promise of God. The life that is fully devoted to God, holds nothing back.
- 3). Caleb never lost hope. Even he was forty years in the desert he never lost his hope. No matter the setback, Caleb held onto promises of God.
- 4). Caleb was example of unshakable faith and pursuit of God's will during the tough times.

For followers of Jesus Christ like the Caleb is the incredible example. As we face the difficulties of life, setbacks and disappointments, we must never lose focus on God's promises.

We should be honest with God in telling Him our problems and difficulties which are causing our faith to shake. We should ask God to help us. Let us ask God to have faith like Caleb in the tough times and difficult situations!
