In Acts chapter 3 a born lame man was healed as Peter demanded healing of a lame man in Jesus' name. The Jewish leaders were so furious about that and they arrested Peter and John and kept them over night and next day morning questioned them but did not find any criminal charges against them. And whole council at that time wondered to see the healing of a born lame man they used to see him every day sitting in front of the Temple begging. They let the Peter and John let go.

"21. So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding nothing how they might punish them, because of the people: for all men glorified God for that which was done. 22. For man was above forty years old, on whom this miracle of healing was shewed: 23. And being let go, they went to their own company, and reported all that the chief priests and elders had said unto them. 24. And when they heard that, they lifted their voices to God with one accord, and said, Lord, thou art God, which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is:"

It amazes me to see that as soon as Peter and John were let go they straight way went to the church where other believers were praying for Peter and John. As soon as they went to the church they reported everything to the church all that the chief priests had said to them. **And as soon as they heard that they all were inspired by the Holy Spirit they lifted up their voices to God with one accord, thanked Him for what He has done in and through their lives!**

As believers we do better together. We are stronger together. We fast we pray we intercede for each other. Even apostles were plugged into church—they needed the prayer and encouragement and the church was there for them.

Hebrews 10:25: "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching."

In Matthew Chapter 16 we read marvelous truth revealed by Peter about Jesus and Jesus revealed wonderful truth about the church: "13. When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, whom do men say that I the Son of man am? 14. And they said, some say that thou art John the Baptist: some, Elias; and others, Jeremias, or one of the prophets. 15. He saith unto them, but whom say ye that I am? 16. And Simon Peter answered and said, thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God."

Look what Jesus said, "17. And Jesus answered and said unto him, blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven. 18. And I say also unto thee, that thou art Peter, **and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.**" **Yes, indeed the good news is the gates of hell cannot prevail against us as a church** when we come together and pray and worship the Lord and share our prayer concerns, burdens and with one accord bring before the Throne of grace!

Yes, **WE NEED EACH OTHER!** As the body of Christ we must not forsake assembling ourselves together to exhort one another, pray for one another and so much the more as we see the day approaching!
