Look what the Psalmist says, "1. How amiable are thy tabernacles, O LORD of hosts! 2. After we know this truth, how much more we must love Him! "And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might (Deuteronomy 6:5). "And now, Israel, what doth the LORD thy God require of thee, but to fear the LORD thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the LORD thy God with all thy h eart and with all thy sou" (Deuteronomy 10:12).
